I'm writing because public records indicate you are not registered to vote. You may be listed as unregistered if you have moved, changed your name, or have not recently voted. We are ramping up our political outreach this year, and you play a critical role.

In 2023, the IBEW has our work cut out for us – from protecting collective bargaining and workers' rights to capitalizing on the work opportunities presented by recently passed infrastructure and energy legislation. These and other bills enacted in the past two years give us an unprecedented opportunity to expand our ranks. Elections this year and in 2024 will determine the fate of our jobs, benefits, and union. Informed IBEW members who are registered to vote and armed with the facts necessary to vote for candidates who support us are the most important piece of our 2023 mobilization plan.

We need representatives in Washington who support project labor agreements and advocate for policies that create and protect our jobs.
