The IBEW PAC collects voluntary contributions from U.S. IBEW members and local unions to support pro-labor candidates, ballot initiatives, and legislation.



The hub for all IBEW political contributions, the IBEW PAC empowers the Government Affairs Department to impact decisions that affect IBEW members by driving a policy agenda that prioritizes IBEW members.

The IBEW PAC is bipartisan and supports labor friendly candidates from both sides of the political aisle.

Your local union officers decide how member contributions to the IBEW PAC should be spent.

The IBEW PAC is funded through voluntary contributions from hundreds of thousands of IBEW members throughout the United States. National treasury money is NOT contributed directly to candidates for office.

Get involved with IBEW PAC

Donate at Conferences/Meetings

 Contributions made to the IBEW PAC at conferences or meetings are credited to your local union, so you are essentially donating directly to your local union Political Action Committee.

Check-Off
