I'm writing because public records indicate you are not registered to vote. You may be listed as unregistered if you have moved, changed your name, or have not recently voted. We are ramping up our electoral outreach this year, and you play a critical role.

In 2024, the IBEW has our work cut out for us – from protecting collective bargaining and workers' rights to capitalizing on the massive work opportunities presented by recently passed infrastructure and energy bills. Because of them, ground is breaking on projects across the country, from semiconductor plants to new transmission lines to high speed railroads, all with strong labor standards. As a result of these laws, demand for electricians is expected to spike to 200,000 in 2030. IBEW's membership is climbing and these and other bills enacted in the past three years give us an unprecedented opportunity to continue to expand our ranks and heighten the growing influence of this union.

Informed IBEW members who are registered and armed with the facts necessary to vote for candidates who support us are the most important piece of our 2024 mobilization plan.

On the local, state and national levels, we need more champions who support the rights of union members and allies who will stand up to those who are working to defeat us. We need representatives in Washington who support project labor agreements and advocate for policies that create and protect our jobs.
