

WHY SHOULD YOU VOTE?

Voting is one of the most powerful ways to make your voice heard in our democracy, but in 2020, only 66.8% of the voting-age population in the United States reported voting.

Modern technology has improved access to information on candidates and made it easier to register to vote in many areas, and it is vital to be aware of how you can participate in the 2024 election cycle.



CONNECTICUT'S ABSENTEE AND MAIL-IN VOTING PROCEDURES

Permanent absentee / mail-in voting procedures:

- Excuse required to request an absentee ballot
- Applications can be submitted via mail, in-person, email, and fax

CONNECTICUT'S EARLY VOTING DEADLINES

Early Voting Begins: October 21, 2024 Early Voting Ends: November 3, 2024

DEADLINES TO KNOW FOR VOTING IN CONNECTICUT

October 29, 2024

7 days before an election. Same-day registration is permitted on Election Day

ABSENTEE / MAIL-IN VOTING BALLOT DEADLINES:

Request must be received by

November 4, 2024

The day before the election. If faxing or emailing application, the original application form must be received by close of polls on Election Day or the mail-ballot will not count.

BALLOT SUBMISSION DEADLINE:

Ballots must be received by the close of polls on Election Day, or the day before if handdelivered by the voter, and by the close of polls if delivered by a designated agent.
