- Peltola fought for Alaska's working families her entire first term in office
- Peltola secured over \$2 billion from the Inflation Reduction Act and Bipartisan Infrastructure Law for infrastructure and energy projects in Alaska—improving roads, bridges, ports, energy sources, and airports while creating new IBEW job opportunities
- Peltola played a crucial role in getting approval from the Biden administration for the Willow Project, a 30-year venture that will create over 2,500 construction jobs and 300 long-term jobs
- Peltola was one of just eight House Democrats who refused to vote for a rail contract that didn't include sick days for workers
- Peltola cosponsored the PRO Act, which expands labor protections for workers' rights to organize and collectively bargain in the workplace
- Alaska is a labor state, and our labor unions unanimously support Peltola because she supports union workers in our fight for better pay, benefits, and working conditions
