



GET OUT THE VOTE

in California

Voting is one of the most powerful ways to make your voice heard in our democracy, but in 2024, only 64% of the voting-age population in the United States reported voting.

Modern technology has improved access to information on candidates and made it easier to register to vote in many areas, and it is vital to be aware of how you can participate in the 2026 election cycle.

PRIMARY ELECTION TYPE:

Top-Two

Candidates are listed on a common ballot regardless of party. In this system, the top two vote-getters advance to the general election.



ABSENTEE AND MAIL-IN VOTING PROCEDURES

Permanent absentee/ mail-in voting procedures:

Ballots are delivered to all voters.

EARLY VOTING:

Begins



May 4

Ends



June 2

DEADLINES TO KNOW FOR VOTING IN California



VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE:

May 18

15 days before the election. Same-day registration is permitted 14 days before the election and on Election Day.

ABSENTEE / MAIL-IN VOTING BALLOT DEADLINES:

Ballots are delivered to all voters

BALLOT SUBMISSION DEADLINE:

Postmarked by Election Day

Must be received no later than seven days after Election Day.
