## VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE:

## April 6

29 days before the election.

## ABSENTEE / MAIL-IN VOTING BALLOT DEADLINES:

Request must be received by

## April 23

12 days before the election for mail requests.

**BALLOT SUBMISSION DEADLINE:**

## Mail receipt by Election Day

Must be received by 6 PM on Election Day.
