I'm writing because public records indicate you are not registered to vote. You may have been listed as unregistered if you moved, changed your name, or have not voted recently. The IBEW is reaching out to voters like you because this is a critical electoral year.

In 2026, with control of Congress, key governor's races, and critical statehouses on the line, the IBEW has our work cut out for us. As national debates intensify around energy policy, infrastructure investment, and workplace protections, defending collective bargaining and countering anti-labor efforts depends on electing leaders who stand with union labor. Supporting pro-labor candidates ensures IBEW members' jobs, wages, benefits, and jobsite safety remain a priority for lawmakers.

The most important piece of the IBEW's mobilization plan is an informed membership that is registered and ready to vote. When equipped with the facts, IBEW members can turn out at the local, state, and national levels to help elect leaders who will stand up for union workers and advance policies that protect our jobs.
