Voting is one of the most powerful ways to make your voice heard in our democracy, but in 2024, only 64% of the voting-age population in the United States reported voting.

Modern technology has improved access to information on candidates and made it easier to register to vote in many areas, and it is vital to be aware of how you can participate in the 2026 election cycle.



ABSENTEE AND MAIL-IN VOTING PROCEDURES

Permanent absentee / mail-in voting procedures:

- Excuse required to request an absentee ballot
- Applications can be submitted by mail, in-person, email, or fax

DEADLINES TO KNOW FOR VOTING IN

Arkansas



VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE:

October 5

29 days before the election.

ABSENTEE / MAIL-IN VOTING BALLOT DEADLINES:

Request must be received by

October 27

7 days before the election for requests submitted by mail, fax, or online; 4 days before the election for in-person requests.

BALLOT SUBMISSION DEADLINE:

Mail receipt by Election Day

Must be received by 7:30 PM on Election Day. Hand-delivered ballots must be received at the county clerk's office by the close of business the Friday before Election Day.
