Voting is one of the most powerful ways to make your voice heard in our democracy, but in 2024, only 64% of the voting-age population in the United States reported voting.

Modern technology has improved access to information on candidates and made it easier to register to vote in many areas, and it is vital to be aware of how you can participate in the 2026 election cycle.



ABSENTEE AND MAIL-IN VOTING PROCEDURES

Permanent absentee / mail-in voting procedures:

- No excuse required to request an absentee ballot
- Applications can be submitted by mail, in-person, or online

DEADLINES TO KNOW FOR VOTING IN

Connecticut



VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE:

October 16

18 days before the election. Same-day registration is permitted during early voting and on Election Day.

ABSENTEE / MAIL-IN VOTING BALLOT DEADLINES:

Request must be received by

November 2

1 day before the election for in-person requests.

BALLOT SUBMISSION DEADLINE:

Mail receipt by Election Day

Must be received by the close of polls on Election Day. Hand-delivered ballots must be received the day before the election if delivered by the voter and by the close of polls on Election Day if delivered by a designated agent of a voter who is ill or physically disabled.
