Voting is one of the most powerful ways to make your voice heard in our democracy, but in 2024, only 64% of the voting-age population in the United States reported voting.

Permanent absentee / mail-in voting procedures:

- Excuse required to request an absentee ballot
- Applications can be submitted by mail, in-person, email, fax, or online

VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE:

October 5

29 days before the election.

ABSENTEE / MAIL-IN VOTING BALLOT DEADLINES:

Request must be received by

October 22

12 days before the election for mail requests.

BALLOT SUBMISSION DEADLINE:

Mail receipt by Election Day

Must be received by 6 PM on Election Day.

HOW YOU CAN REGISTER TO VOTE IN INDIANA

To register to vote in Indiana, visit the State Board of Elections website for more information on voter eligibility and the registration process.

STATE ELECTION OFFICE

You can begin the registration process through Indiana's Online Voter Registration System.
