Voting is one of the most powerful ways to make your voice heard in our democracy, but in 2024, only 64% of the voting-age population in the United States reported voting.

Permanent absentee / mail-in voting procedures:

- No excuse required to request an absentee ballot
- Applications can be submitted by mail, in-person, or fax

VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE:

October 13

21 days before the election.

ABSENTEE / MAIL-IN VOTING BALLOT DEADLINES:

Request must be received by

October 27

The Tuesday before the election.

BALLOT SUBMISSION DEADLINE:

Mail receipt by Election Day

Must be received by 12 PM on Election Day.
