Voting is one of the most powerful ways to make your voice heard in our democracy, but in 2024, only 64% of the voting-age population in the United States reported voting.

Modern technology has improved access to information on candidates and made it easier to register to vote in many areas, and it is vital to be aware of how you can participate in the 2026 election cycle.

DEADLINES TO KNOW FOR VOTING IN

Vermont



VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE:

November 3

Same-day registration is permitted through Election Day.

ABSENTEE / MAIL-IN VOTING BALLOT DEADLINES:

Ballots are delivered to all voters

BALLOT SUBMISSION DEADLINE:

Mail receipt by Election Day

Must be received by the close of polls on Election Day. Ballots hand-delivered to a drop box or the town clerk's office must be received before the close of business on the day before the election; ballots hand-delivered to the voter's polling place must be received by the close of polls on Election Day.
