Voting is one of the most powerful ways to make your voice heard in our democracy, but in 2024, only 64% of the voting-age population in the United States reported voting.

Modern technology has improved access to information on candidates and made it easier to register to vote in many areas, and it is vital to be aware of how you can participate in the 2026 election cycle.



ABSENTEE AND MAIL-IN VOTING PROCEDURES

Permanent absentee / mail-in voting procedures:

- Excuse required to request an absentee ballot
- Applications can be submitted by mail, in-person, email, or fax

DEADLINES TO KNOW FOR VOTING IN

West Virginia



VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE:

October 13

21 days before the election.

ABSENTEE / MAIL-IN VOTING BALLOT DEADLINES:

Request must be received by

October 28

6 days before the election.

BALLOT SUBMISSION DEADLINE:

Postmarked by Election Day

Must be received before the canvass (which begins on the fifth day after the election) if postmarked on or before Election Day.

HOW YOU CAN REGISTER TO VOTE IN WEST VIRGINIA
